

A Lean Six Sigma – Green Belt certification course will be held at École de Technologie Supérieure (ÉTS) in downtown Montreal from August 10th to 21st 2015.

It will be a two week program, where training will be provided by trainers and professionals from Canada Post Corporation.

Classes will take place on weekdays from 8:30 to 16:30. Theory and study cases will be seen during the day. You will be asked to come along on industrial visits in order to complete a team project. Homework will be done during your free time.

After the course, a case study will be handed to students to be completed at home, alone or in a team.

Once the course is succeeded, students will be given the Lean Six Sigma – Green Belt certification. Many social activities will be organized in order for you to get to know your colleagues and to discover Montreal.

- 1) Must be a registered student in a engineering program at a Canadian school/university during the Winter 2015 semester;
- 2) IMPORTANT: Must be a student member of an engineering society member of the Canadian Federation of Engineering Students (CFES).

- 3) Due to the course's limited spots, applications will be go through a screening process based on the following criteria:
 - a) Quality of resume;
 - b) Quality of cover letter,
 - c) Relevance of experience and discipline
 - d) Official transcript of school grades
 - e) Respect of due date for documents and their format.
